I want to have this community outreach in the spring/summer with pony rides, petting zoo. I would also like to have our local police be there for safety checks on car seats and to be able to do an identity thing for the kids. The only

thing I ask is that we have an admission fee of bringing a non-perishable food item, hygiene product, paper product, or cat & dog food for admission. Food, drinks are extra. My point being, do I have enough help to pull it off? Are we going to be wishy washy about the date for this to take place. I again would like to reach out to the community but am not sure how this will work seeing we have tried different things at different times and they never seem to attract enough people to make it a success.
