#### From the Pastor's Pen:

We are now just one month away from Easter. How ready are you? On Easter Jesus arose from the dead to give eternal life for all of us. Prior to Easter Sunday, Jesus had experienced and endured betrayal, denial and abandonment all by his most trusted friends and followers. Each of us must ask ourselves, where would we be in the shadow of the Cross? Would we run and hide, or deny him or would we be like the women and John at his feet worshiping him in prayer? Jesus' death on the cross provides us with the opportunity to reexamine our own spiritual lifestyles. Do we follow him only in the good times where everything is going good, or do we turn to



him only when crisis hits? Following him should be on our minds all of our lives. He asks very little of us. Just to give to him our loyalty and to reach out to the least in society in caring and kindness as he would? His death and resurrection is an invitation for each of us to make a commitment to new life. We were forgiven for past transgressions, and are now able to live lives of righteousness. The hymn reads, Were you there when they crucified my Lord? His death on the cross was not the end, but the resurrection opens the door to new life. May your Holy week and Easter celebrations be fulfilling for each of you. Amen.
