When my wife and I were serving in ministry in Maryland, there was a United Church of Christ pastor down the road named Rev. John Mingus. He once shared with us the story of two couples in his church.

<u>The first couple, Andy and Priscilla, had moved into town to begin their dream.</u> Andy had finished law school, passed the bar, and was ready to start a law practice. Andy and Priscilla put down roots. The practice grew. The two became four. They were happy.

The second couple, Carole and Greg, moved in next door to Pastor Mingus and became good friends. But on the day Greg inspected the new house, he hit his head and soon developed seizures. Tests revealed a brain tumor. Before he died, Greg stood in the pulpit of their church one Sunday and spoke of life and death. The church grieved with them.

Andy and Priscilla's dream also shattered, when one day Andy came home from work and discovered his wife and children had been brutally and senselessly murdered. The church was there for him throughout the months of court trial and the continuing pain.

The murderer was put in prison, and Andy's life went on. Carole buried Greg and her life went on. For both of them, the church was a place where they found people who would hold them and weep with them, people who helped each other forge a faith that could weather any storm, people who taught one another how to create meaning out of meaninglessness.

Rev. Mingus tells the rest of the story:

On a New Year's Day, **Andy** and **Carole** were married. And the church was packed. There was a sense not only of celebration but also of resurrection. It felt less like January first than Easter Sunday! There was not a dry eye in the house. Together we learned that there is always hope for new life. In the church we discover again and again that Easter is not an old, idle tale. Easter is a present, powerful reality.
